Cannabis Retailers Create “Green Wednesday”

Cannabis distributors and retailers are promoting “Green Wednesday” as an unofficial shopping holiday ahead of Black Friday, Small Business Saturday and Cyber Monday. And it’s working.

Last year, sales of vape pens, edibles, drinkables and other cannabis products were double the amount of a typical Wednesday.

This year also brings the highest number of states that have legalized recreational cannabis to date. Massachusetts just



opened the door for cannabis sales, although only two dispensaries are currently operating.

And for those in the market for holiday gifts, there are a number of options. Zoma Cannabis launched a mistletoe cannabis named “Mistletoke.”

Legislative Updates: Cannabis Wins on Election Day

The cannabis industry celebrated another victorious election season this November. Utah and Missouri legalized medical marijuana and Michigan voted to legalize cannabis recreationally.

They join 30 states and the District of Columbia, who have passed either medical or recreational legalization legislation.

The successful measures also brings cannabis one step closer to being legal nationally. Support for cannabis legalization is at an all-time high of more than two-thirds of the US population. But Congress has yet to follow voter wishes.



The Senate Appropriations Committee rejected a proposal that would allow banks to work with cannabis companies, and stripped another amendment that would have allowed veterans to obtain medical marijuana in states where it's legal.

Despite these setbacks, the outlook for cannabis is very positive, with members of both political parties in favor of legalization efforts.
